- Give the intern an opportunity to discover, use and grow their gifts. The intern will be required to do a wide variety of things for the ministry (see below). **Responsibilities:**

The internship has both relational and administrative components to the job description. Goals will be set, tasks will be assigned, and expectations will be communicated and reviewed on an ongoing basis. The work week will somewhat vary week to week but always include: administrative tasks, ministry contact appointments, ministry event planning, staff meetings,
